In some cases the object of the book is dealt with literally, using skill based practices to transform the life of antique books. Other artists base their work on folklore, mythology and storytelling, creating their own narratives through their detailed drawing practices. The medium of paper is explored and experimented with until it reaches its boundaries. Dream-like qualities and notions of escapism appear in much of the work; a common theme within both art and literature.
